Questions

1. The first part of the report deals with the 'horological significance' of the clock and statue. About how many other Jack Clocks are there in Britain?
2. What evidence is there about the date of the clock's construction?
3. Does the section on 'The Clockmaker' tie in with that date? Explain your reasoning.
4. There are a number of 'speculative' interpretations offered about the statue. List them in order of probability (in your opinion) and explain which you consider to be the most likely.
5. How many times has the statue been moved? Why might this be important? Explain in as much detail as you can.
6. How would you describe the tone of Fisher's observations about the clock and statue?
7. How would you describe the tone of Mr T. R. Robinson's wish in 1961?
8. What would happen if there was a recommendation to move the statue?
9. What do you think should happen to the clock and statue, and why?
10. How would you describe the tone of the report? Explain your answer.
11. Further research: find about 'Retain and Explain'. Then look back you your answer to question 5.
